This special G-COE seminar is designed to help young scholars get published in peer-reviewed international journals as well as academic presses in Asia-Pacific, the United States and Europe. The seminar consists of two parts.

The first is a series of lectures by G-COE professors, visiting fellows at CSEAS and other institutions at Kyoto University, and invited senior scholars who will be asked to share with the participants their experience in getting published abroad. The seminar will also invite academic publishers in Japan and abroad to share insights on how to get published. The second part will be a continuous discussion among the participants on the manuscripts (journal articles and/or books) that they plan to submit for publication. At this point, the focus will be on the social sciences and the humanities, but the special seminar will, in the near future, be focused on dialogue between humanities, social science and science, an end in view of publishing materials that reflect inter-disciplinary G-COE themes.
